



## **BRIGITTE WARNER SCHOLARSHIP**

### **GUIDELINES**

Applicant must be a current member in good standing of the Middle Atlantic Chapter and is expected to maintain membership for the following school year. Applicant must also be a member of the American Orff-Schulwerk Association.

Scholarship money will not exceed \$1,000.00 and is to be used for tuition fees and required materials for Levels I, II, III, or a Master Class, or further education related to Orff Schulwerk. Priority will be given to applicants using funds to complete their Levels education.

Recipient must be currently teaching music to children in a public or independent school setting, at least half-time.

Upon successful completion of the coursework, the recipient is asked to contribute a short article for the chapter newsletter about their experience. Additionally, the recipient is expected to present a short activity as part of the annual Middle Atlantic Chapter Sharing Workshop.

- Applicant **must** submit a letter of reference/recommendation from their employer or a prior Levels Instructor.
