



SUMMER SUPPLEMENTAL STUDY SCHOLARSHIP

GUIDELINES

Applicant must be a current member in good standing of the Middle Atlantic Chapter and is expected to maintain membership for the following school year.

Scholarship money will not exceed \$500.00, and is to be used for tuition fees and required materials for a summertime “supplemental” AOSA-accredited teacher education course or closely-related Orff-Schulwerk training experience (e.g., the Orff-Afrique Master Class or the International Summer Course at the Orff Institute). Scholarship funds will not be granted for non-Schulwerk training. ***NOTE: This scholarship is not intended for two-week Levels training courses.*** Middle Atlantic Chapter members in good standing can apply for financial aid for two-week Levels programs through the Brigitte Warner and Brian Powilatis Scholarships.

Applicant must be currently teaching music to children in a public or independent school setting, at least half-time.

The scholarship recipient will write a short article for the Chapter newsletter about their experience upon successful completion of their coursework. Additionally, the recipient is expected to present a short activity as part of the annual Chapter Sharing Workshop.

TO APPLY: Print the following Application Page and complete all fields, and attach an Orff-Schulwerk Curriculum Vitae (details below).

No letter of reference or recommendation is required to apply to this scholarship. Members may apply to more than one Middle Atlantic Chapter scholarship in a given application cycle, but are unlikely to win more than one per cycle.

All application materials must be emailed, hand delivered, or postmarked by **March 17, 2018**.

The Scholarship Committee will contact all applicants about their status by **April 1, 2018**.
